Ways To Improve IATS Performance

Adjust the Cache in the SQL Service:

- 1. Remote into the server or go to the desktop.
- 2. Open Services.
- 3. **Scroll down** to "SQL Anywhere 12 Winiats".
- 4. **Right-click** and **click** on **Stop**.
- 5. **Open** Windows Explorer.
- 6. **Browse** to your **IATS DB** (probably c:\program files (x86)\windowsiats\database or e:\program files (x86)\windowsiats\database).
- 7. Calculate 10-15 percent of your DB size and save it.
- 8. **Browse** to the **root of C:.**
- 9. Right-click on Createsvc.bat.
- 10. Click on Edit.
- 11. **Adjust** the –c xxm or –c xxg to –c and the number saved in step 7.
- 12. Click on File and Exit.
- 13. **Double-click** the **createsvc.bat**.
- 14. **Press <Y>**es at the prompt to overwrite the existing service in the command prompt box.
- 15. When the command prompt closes, **Close** Windows Explorer.
- 16. Maximize Services.
- 17. **Scroll down** to "SQL Anywhere 12 Winiats".
- 18. Right-click and click on Start.
- 19. Close Services.
