## ***Invalid SSN's***

The Social Security Administration (SSA) has mandated that certain social security numbers (SSN) are invalid. The list of SSN's that the SSA has mandated as being invalid is as follows:

- a) SSN's with all zeros in any of the 3 sections of the SSN (e.g. 000-98-754, 754-00 -9712, 987-65-0000)
- b) SSN's with all 6's in the first section of the SSN (e.g. 666-98-7654)
- c) SSN 078-05-1120 ("Wallet SSN")
- d) SSN 111-11-1111
- e) SSN 123-45-6789
- f) SSN 219-09-9999
- g) All SSN's from sequence number 987-65-4320 through 987-65-4329
- h) SSN 999-99-9999

It is highly recommended that you cease and desist immediately from using these invalid SSN's. If you would like to know if your site is currently using any of these invalid SSN's, items c) through h) can be manually queried using the history module in IATS. If you would like a query for items a) and b), please contact the IATS Help Desk by email (IATS-HELP-DESK@DFAS.MIL, or via phone at 317-212-7718 or DSN 699-7718 for the query and assistance in running the query. It is anticipated at this time that IATS version 6.17 will address disallowing these SSN's to be used.

## ***Windows 7 SP1***

IATS will currently not work under WINDOWS7 if the first service pack (SP1) has been installed. Version 6.16 of the IATS software, which will be out later in the year, will include an installer that will work with WIN7/SP1. If you have already installed WIN7/SP1 and cannot wait for the new version, you must uninstall SP1 for IATS to work.
